Father Capodanno Clay Flurry Fundraiser

The event consists of a 4-person team. The teams will shoot 50 clay pigeons in two minutes. Multiple rounds to qualify for top three places who receive awards. All skill level of shooters welcome. All proceeds go to Father Vincent Capodanno High School annual fund.

Entry fee for the flurry is \$125 per individual or \$500 per 4-person team. Shotguns and ammunition will be provided. Participants are welcome to bring their own shotguns. Each team member should bring their own eye and ear protection; some will be available to borrow. Prior to kicking off the Clay Flurry festivities, each participant will be required to attend a Shooter Safety Meeting.

The Capodanno PTO will have refreshments and food for purchase throughout the event.
